Mick Isbell is the Managing Director of the Interstate Department of First Records Retrieval, a member of the First Legal Network. His specialization is in interstate discovery, which among other things, provides expertise in issuing out-of-state subpoenas. Mr. Isbell has been in the attorney service business since starting his own service in 1973. He graduated from Cal Poly University with degrees in Business and History and has been a member of the California Association of Legal Support Professionals (CALSPRO) since 1976. Mr. Isbell was President and Chairman of the Board of CALSPRO from 1979-1983, and as Legislative Committee Chairman from 1984-1985, he helped write legislation that amended Business and Professions Code § 22450 et seq, which created professional process servers and registered professional copiers. Mr. Isbell has worked with California's Judicial Council to create the form Subpoena for Production of Business Records, and is currently the only certified on-site trainer appointed by the US District Court for training on the Central District's CM/ECF system.

Mr. Isbell will provide valuable information on registering your attorneys to use the system, technical specifications for documents, avoiding mistakes, updates on the system and what's on the horizon for the Central District's CM/ECF system in 2012. If you file documents in federal court, or plan to file in federal court in the future, you must attend this seminar to learn what's required to efficiently manage your federal cases.
