## **Volunteer Paralegals Sought for Family Law Program**

The Harriett Buhai Center for Family Law, a non-profit provider of legal assistance in the areas of custody, support, domestic violence, paternity and divorce, to low-income persons in Los Angeles, seeks qualified paralegals to participate in its program. Individuals who are eligible to apply must be persons meeting the standards for paralegal practice pursuant to Section 6450 of California Business and Professions Code. Preference will be given to individuals who possess a certificate of completion from a paralegal program approved by the American Bar Association or other accrediting organization, and/or have fluency in Spanish, and/or have two or more years experience in the family law field. Prospective volunteers are asked to attend the Center's day-long training before participating. Volunteers are supervised by the Center's staff attorneys and receive ongoing training and instruction.

Students attending accredited paralegal programs may be eligible for consideration as interns for a semester at the Center upon application and personal interview.
